DK Series WS is a high quality range of products, tested to European attack test standards. DK Series WS has passed the prestigious European EN14450-S2 test meaning that in normal circumstances, and provided the safe is properly fitted, it carries an overnight cash rating of £4,000, or ten times this sum for jewellery and valuables. If the precise rating is important it is advisable to check with your insurance company.

- The safe is equipped with a high-security lock with double-bitted key, and is supplied with 2 keys.
- **Keep the keys in a secure place – not in the safe!**
- **If both the keys are lost, the safe will have to be forced open.**

DO NOT LUBRICATE THE LOCK. IF NECESSARY, LUBRICATE THE LOCKING BOLTS.

WARRANTY

- The DK Series WS carries a 2-year warranty in respect of materials and workmanship.
- The warranty is valid upon presentation of a receipt or invoice indicating date of purchase.

OPENING THE SAFE:

Insert the key into the keyhole. Please note that the key only fits the lock in one position. **Do not force the key.**

Turn the key clockwise until it stops. The handle can now be rotated clockwise until the bolts are fully retracted.

CLOSING THE SAFE

Insert the key into the keyhole. Please note that the key only fits the lock in one position. Do not force the key.

Ensure that the bolts are fully retracted (the bolts are the metal pins which protrude from the side of the door and thus secure the safe). If necessary rotate the handle clockwise to retract the bolts.

Gently push the door shut using the handle. Always ensure that there are no objects or people in the way of the closing door. Ensure that your fingers are clear from the edge of the door and that nothing is protruding from safe.

Turn the handle anti-clockwise until the bolts are fully engaged.

Turn the key anti-clockwise until it stops.

Remove the key from the lock.
